In exchange, the Downtown Women's Center provides job opportunities, furniture, appliances, clothes and household items to former residents of Boys Ranch or Girlstown, U.S.A. and clients of Cal Farley's Family Resource Centers

In addition to managing the retail aspect of both Thrift Towns, last fiscal year the Downtown Women's

Center gave away \$49,000.00 worth of merchandise to people in need throughout the community. The

referrals to the Downtown Women's Center came from over 40 different agencies, churches and

shelters. Diann Gilmore, Executive Director of the Downtown Women's Center, says, "We are just

grateful for the opportunity to assist other agencies and their clients."

Cal Farley's cares for approximately 310 at-risk boys and girls at its two campuses – Cal Farley's Boys

Ranch and Cal Farley's Girlstown, U.S.A. Children from pre-school through high school are accepted

with no charge to their families. The Cal Farley programs provide a variety of academic, vocational,

spiritual and extra-curricular activities for the children in care, in a Christ-centered environment.

The anniversary of this "Partnership of Caring" will be commemorated by words from Dan Adams,

President and Chief Executive Officer of Cal Farley's, Diann Gilmore and an individual that has

greatly benefited from the employment opportunity provided by Thrift Town Too. Additionally,
